Captain Crackers' KINDNESS MAP GAME

Ahoy, me hearties!

This game helps little pirates learn that being kind is the greatest treasure of all!

Every time you do something kind, you get to move along the map toward the treasure chest at the end.

When you reach it — celebrate with a big “Yo-ho-ho!” and a happy dance! 



How to Play (Home or Classroom)

1. Print your Kindness Map and hang it somewhere you can see every day — like the fridge, classroom wall, or bedroom door.
2. Start at the “START” flag at the bottom of the map.
3. Do a kind act from the map (or make up your own!).
4. Each time you’re kind, colour in the corresponding heart on the dotted path.
5. When you reach the treasure chest, you’ve completed your kindness quest!

(Parents and teachers can choose a small reward — like a pirate cheer, sticker, or dance to one of Captain Crackers’ songs!)



For Educators and Group Leaders

- Use the map as part of a classroom kindness week.
- Create a crew chart where each child moves their name along a shared poster map.
- Pair it with a “Kindness Jar” — when it fills with tokens, hold a mini celebration.
